Age Guidelines (Number of requirements needed to receive the excellence award is based on age)

- Members age 7-13, required to have completed and checked requirement numbers 1 - 6 and a minimum of three of the remaining requirements to receive the Excellence Award.
- Members age 14 and older, required to have completed and checked requirement numbers 1 - 6 and a minimum of five of the remaining requirements to receive the Excellence Award.

A Reading at 4-H Club Day will count. Does not have to be in this specific project. (Same talk or demonstration may be used for all project award applications.) **To receive credit for this must list name of talk(s) and where given.**
- _____ 6. Exhibit at the Elk County 4-H Fair in this project. **List your exhibit(s); not the number of exhibits to receive credit.**
- _____ 7. Served as an assistant project leader **IN THIS** project for your club. **Explain in General 4-H Story and/or Permanent Record.**
